The Scientific Poster Competition is organized as part of the scientific conference programme at IDEM Singapore.

The Scientific Poster Competition provides a platform to both the clinician and the researcher, to present their most recent findings in the field of dentistry. Through the competition, we hope that it can benefit the dental community in one way or another.

Thus, if you have a new finding, a new invention or innovation in the field of dentistry, we urge you to come forward and participate in this competition.

Winners of the poster competition will win attractive cash prizes.

How to Participate

At present, we are calling for submissions of an abstract of the intended presentation.

There will be a preliminary judging by a panel of judges comprising of distinguished experts in the various disciplines of dentistry. They will then select the finalists for the main competition at IDEM Singapore 2010.

Finalists will have to be registered delegates of IDEM Singapore 2010 (Early Bird registration fees apply!)

The finalists will have to be present at IDEM Singapore 2010 for the finals of the scientific poster competition. They will have to present their papers in the form of a poster, and also to receive a short Q&A session with the panel of judges.

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

All abstract(s) must be submitted in English. On-line submission is preferred. Email submissions must be saved on Windows Microsoft Word document. The maximum number of words allowed is 250.

Deadline for submission of abstract(s) is 31 December 2009 (2359 GMT+8). Please provide the Secretariat with your email address so that we can send you the results of the abstract submission and further instructions. Abstract(s) accepted for presentation MUST be presented by registered participants at the main conference.

Poster Presentation

You are provided with a one-sided panel board (white in colour) with dimensions of 2m (width) x 1m (height), you are not required to use up the entire space.

Posters will be displayed from 16 to 18 April 2010 during the allocated period after which the posters should be removed within the stipulated time given.

Authors are fully responsible for display and removal of their posters at the respective locations. The Scientific Committee will not be liable for any loss or damage to the posters during the display.

Velcro tapes are supplied by the secretariat to mount the posters on the assigned panels. No nails are allowed on the panels.

When preparing text and illustrations, bear in mind that the posters will be viewed from a distance of about 1m.
